Judgment on 24.08.2023

Learned Advocate Md. Shuel Islam Khan for the accused-petitioner submits that the parties have entered into compromise between the convict-accused-petitioner and the complainant-opposite parties to settle the matter out of court.

On the other hand learned Advocate Mrs. Joya Bhattacharjee appeared for the complainant-opposite party No. 2 and concedes with the submission of the learned Advocate for the convict-accused-petitioner.

I have heard the learned Advocates from both sides. It appears that the parties have entered into a compromise to settle the matter out of court.

In the result, the Rule is discharged. The trial court is hereby directed to allow the complainant-opposite parties to withdraw the deposit amount which was deposited by the convict-accused-petitioner at the time of filing appeal. The trial court is also directed to release convict-accused-petitioner from his sentence and conviction in accordance with law.
