Let a Rule Nisi be issued calling upon the respondents to show cause as to why the alleged failure of respondent No.2 in disposing of petitioner's application dated 12.09.2023 (Annexure-G to the writ petition), in accordance with law within reasonable time, should not be declared to be without lawful authority and is of no legal effect and/or such other or further order or orders be passed as to this Court may seem fit and proper.

The Rule is made returnable within 4(four) weeks from date.

Pending hearing of the Rule, respondent No.2 is directed to dispose of petitioner's said application dated 12.09.2023 (Annexure-G to the writ petition) in

accordance with law within a period of 60 (sixty) days from receipt of the copy of this order, upon hearing the petitioner (if necessary).

With the disposal of the said application of the petitioner, the Rule issued in this writ petition shall automatically stand discharged as infructuous.

The petitioner is directed to put in requisites for service of notices upon the respondents in the usual course and through registered post with acknowledgement due (AD).
