**The 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2026**

The plaintiff and the defendant filed a joint application for decreeing the suit on compromise.

It appears that the instant suit has been instituted by the plaintiff/petitioner, namely **Satabdi Datta Gupta @ Satabdi Dutta (Arin)**, impleading her husband, **Silvester Datta Gupta**, as the sole defendant. The matter was duly admitted by this court on 23.12.2025 and upon receipt of summons, the defendant entered appearance on 26.01.2026 through his learned Advocate.

Subsequently, at the intervention of the respective parents and other well-wishers the plaintiff and the defendant amicably decided to dissolve their marital tie. In furtherance of such settlement, both the plaintiff and the defendant jointly filed the instant application praying for a decree of divorce on compromise. They also annexed a Compromise Deed of

Agreement dated 25.02.2026 (notarized on 26.02.2026), marked as Annexure–E to the said application.

Both parties personally appear before this court and the court also examine them. In course of such examination, they categorically stated that they have executed the Compromise Deed as well as the joint application voluntarily and without any coercion, undue influence, misrepresentation, or pressure from any quarter.

Be that as it may, the instant joint application is hereby allowed and the suit be decreed on compromise in terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties.

The Deed of Agreement dated 25.02.2026 (notarized on 26.02.2026), annexed to the application, shall form an integral part of this decree and shall be binding upon both parties. This decree shall be treated as a final decree.
