Earlier the prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by the learned Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Chittagong on 27.06.2013 in Criminal Miscellaneous Case No. 1715 of 2013. An Assistant Director of Anti-Corruption Commission, Head Office, Dhaka on 24.01.2013 lodged an F.I.R. with Kotwali Police Station (C.M.P.), Chittagong against the petitioner and others. In the F.I.R. it was alleged that the offence was committed between September, 2009 to June, 2012. The crux of the allegation made against the petitioner is that the accused petitioner by creating forged documents and showing false bank guarantor obtained composite loan from United Commercial Bank, Khatungonj Branch, Chittagong and Bangladesh Krishi Bank Limited, Agrabad Branch, Chittagong in favour of M/S. Abbas Trading and transferred those loan amount of Tk. 44,35,81,753/- to his and his wife's personnel accounts for the purpose of misappropriating. The accused petitioner obtained ad-interim anticipatory bail from a Division Bench of this Court for a period of 1(one) month and subsequently he appeared before the learned Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Chittagong and submitted bail bond

on 27.02.2013. Thereafter, the petitioner prayed for bail in the Court below and the learned Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Chittagong rejected the prayer for bail by order dated 14.04.2013 and sent the petitioner to jail custody.

It has been stated in the instant application for bail that the accused-petitioner is a well established businessman by profession. He is the sole Proprietor of M/S. Abbas Trading which is an associate member of Chittagong Chamber of Commerce and Industry and also Bangladesh Fertilizer Association. The petitioner is an importer enlisted with Bangladesh Export and Import Control Bureau. He is involved with various social welfare activities. He is the donor member of Chittaogng Women University, Potia College, Anawara Jame Masjid, Hajigura Mia Jame Masjid. He is also lifetime member of Chittagong Club, Ma-O-Shishu Hospital, Chittagong. Accused-petitioner is married and father of four minor children.

The learned Advocate for the accused-petitioner submits that the petitioner is a diabetic patient and has been suffering from acute heard disease since long. He is under medical care and supervision and has been receiving comprehensive medical treatment since 2009 under specialist Doctors from Appolo

Hospital, Bangladesh and Bamrungred International Hospital,
Thailand. While the accused petitioner was in Judicial Custody
he became seriously ill and on 14.03.2013 he made an
application to the learned Chief Metropolitan Magistrate,
Chittagong for sending him to jail hospital for treatment.

The learned Advocate for the petitioner next submits that

The learned Advocate for the petitioner next submits that the instant case arises out of a debt caused due to the supply of poor quality of rice by the supplying company causing huge loss to the petitioner for which a compensation case being Money Suit No. 42/2010 has been filed in the Court of 3rd Joint District Judge, Chittagong and the petitioner's business institution Abbas Trading has incurred a debt to the bank which the petitioner is capable of meeting by selling his property worth more than the debt and if petitioner is granted bail he would attend his business and thus repay the loan, whereas petitioner's incarceration being in jail is most counterproductive for all the parties concerned. The case is still under investigation and charge sheet has not been submitted yet.
